Gift Aid Declarations

Many of you will know already of the Gift Aid Scheme for charities, and may exercise this option for other charities that you support. It is possible for you to extend this advantage to the Ham Amenities Group, and to help us increase our yearly revenue.

The declaration below will enable us to **reclaim £1 on each yearly subscription of £4**. Although this may seem a trivial amount, the cumulative effect can be quite significant. Even if only 100 of our members qualify for Gift Aid, this would make another £100 per year available for the work of the Group, including, of course, the chance for us to contribute more to local charities and good causes.

The Gift Aid scheme only applies if you pay Income Tax. Anybody in receipt of a company pension or of investment income is likely to be in this position, when such sums are added to the State Pension. Those who are still working will certainly be paying Income Tax regularly. The scheme will not lessen your own tax liability, but it will do good for our Group.
