Much of HAG's income, including all profits from Ham Fair, is given to various charities and local good causes. This amounts to several thousand pounds over the past few years.

The **Aims and Objectives of HAG** are to:

1. Promote preservation of our area and to maintain a high standard of cleanliness and tidiness, in conjunction with other local groups
2. Communicate with members regarding local events and issues by regular newsletters
3. Work with the relevant departments of Richmond Borough Council and the local ward councillors with particular reference to:
  - a. keeping the Common and riverside beautiful
  - b. monitoring building developments and other Council decisions
4. Provide finance, through grants, to improve local amenities such as seats on the Common or additional facilities for the young in schools
5. Organise the annual Ham Fair, to arrange lectures, coach trips and fund-raising events such as coffee mornings and garden parties
6. Maintain the Gate House Garden.
